Rules and Terms & Conditions

The competition is open to Otford residents irrespective of age and will be run by The Otford Society (TOS).

All entries must be submitted electronically – please go to our website www.otfordsociety.org.uk or our Facebook page www.facebook.com/otfordsociety for more information and a copy of the entry form which should accompany your photograph.

Entries should be sent to photos@otfordsociety.org.uk and must not exceed 4MB, be in JPEG format and at least 1200 pixels on the longest side.

Images should not include watermarks, borders or signatures.

Black and white images are eligible for entry.

Your image does not have to be taken this year; we will accept older photographs provided they meet the criteria specified.

The closing date for receipt of entries has been extended to 23:59 on Saturday 31st July, 2021.

Only one entry per person will be accepted.

By submitting your contribution, you agree to be legally bound by the following terms and conditions:

You agree that TOS may use your photograph for any purpose and in any way it chooses, including, but not limited to, publicising its work by way of reproduction in print publications as well as online and other social media outlets.

Any submission must be your own original work. It must not infringe the rights of third parties including copyright, trademark, trade secrets, privacy, personal or proprietary rights.

Should your entry feature other people who are recognisable, you will be responsible for ensuring that you have their permission for the photograph to be treated according to the uses set out above. Photographs featuring children under 18 can only be accepted if you are the parent/guardian; by accepting these terms and conditions you grant permission for said photograph to be treated accordingly.

You agree to waive any moral rights in your contribution for the purpose of its submission to and publication on the Society's website and the other purposes already specified.

Copyright of images submitted will remain with the respective photographer. However, each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to TOS when submitting their photograph for entry into the Competition. While every effort will be made to credit photographers, TOS cannot be held responsible should it fail to do so through no fault of its own.

These Terms & Conditions constitute the entire agreement between you and The Otford Society in relation to your entry into the Spring 2021 Photography Competition.

Prize and judging

Judging, initially by TOS Committee, will take place during the second half of June and thereafter the best five entries will be published for Otford residents to have the opportunity to select the winner.

The Otford Society will award a £25 voucher to the overall winner of the competition. In keeping with the Society's mission to support village shops, the voucher can only be redeemed within Otford Village.
