High Street, Otford



What we plan to do and why

As part of the ongoing maintenance works to maintain and improve the highway network in Kent, we will be carrying out work in Otford High Street. These works are to construct a new raised zebra crossing.

The works will require a road closure on the High Street from outside, The Bull public house up to New Forge House. Vehicle access will be given westwards up to and including Otford village car park, and from the East up to New Forge House.

The zebra crossing will remain closed to all highway users while the works are undertaken. Pedestrians will be given access along the footway at all times.

The diversion route for vehicles will be the A225, Sevenoaks & Otford Road, A25 Bradbourne Vale Road & Maidstone Road, A224 London Road, Riverhead and Dunton Green, and the Pilgrims Way West back to the High Street.

When we plan to carry out the work and how long it will take.

The road closure will start from the 9th August until 20th August.

How you can help

We need your help to make sure the work is done as quickly and efficiently as possible. If your vehicle is usually parked on the road, please make sure you park it somewhere else, away from the site whilst these works are carried out, so the road is clear for us to repair. Your patience and co-operation whilst these works are undertaken will be greatly appreciated.

Covid 19 Statement

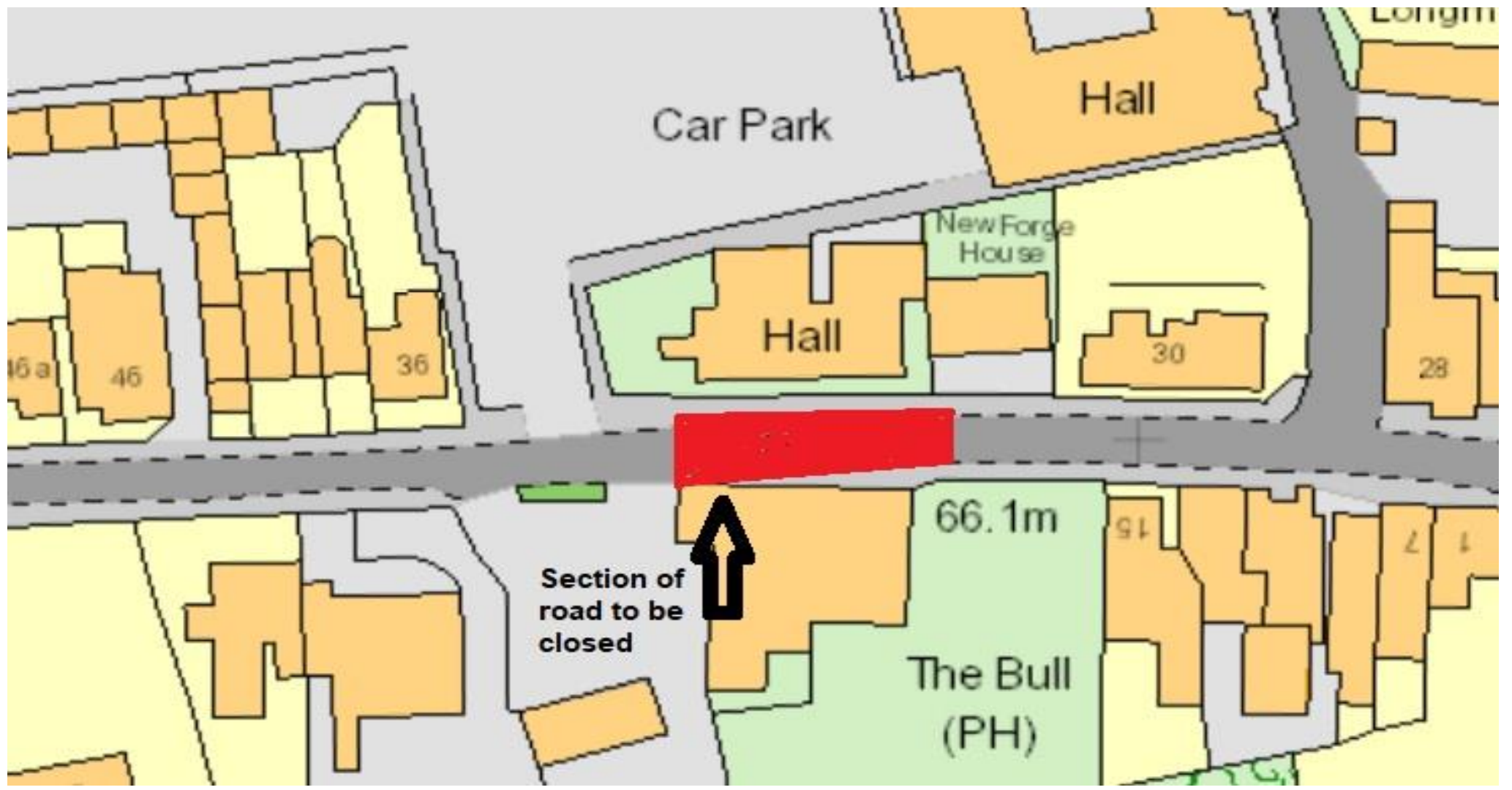
